

# Horse enthusiasts raise money for local therapeutic riding program

MADISON — On Nov. 21, the team at the Mount Washington Valley Mobile Veterinary Clinic gave a check to Amy Mahoney of the Laura Foundation. The donation resulted from funds raised at the Oct. 20 benefit trail ride held for the Foundation. Put on by the Veterinary Clinic, the Hippomaniacs 4H Club and the White Mountain Horse Association, funds raised will go towards the Laura Foundation's therapeutic riding program.

Hikers, along with more than a dozen horseback riders, turned out for the poker trail ride and hike. Riders traversed 10 miles while hikers covered four miles through the Freedom Town Forest and surrounding conservation lands. Participants picked a poker card at five points along the way in hopes of receiving one of the more than 12 prizes awarded at the end for the top poker hands. Local businesses generously donated food for the many volunteers and participants along with the gifts and awards. All participants received a T-shirt.

Altogether the groups, while enjoying the fall foliage and sunny skies, raised \$740 for the Laura Foundation. They plan to repeat the event next year on Sunday, Oct. 19. According to local veterinarian Sandy Brown, "Hopefully, the weather will be as beautiful as it was this year."

The volunteer run Laura Foundation is a local non-profit providing funding to develop and support therapeutic recreation and educational programs that enrich the quality of lives of individuals with autism and/or seizure disorders. Currently, the Foundation is raising funds to build an adaptive sports and recreation center in Madison, just south of Purity Spring Resort in Madison. Phase One, the renovation of an existing building, is nearly complete. Phase Two, consisting of the building of a barn, is the current focus. Aside from its building projects, the Foundation will be embarking in its third summer of programming in 2014.
