Town holds off on regs for Airbnb

CONWAY — Selectmen recently said they won't look into regulating the short-term rental of residential property, made

popular by websites like Airbnb, at least until a proposed bill becomes law or such rentals become a headache in town.

Town officials had said it would be up to selectmen to decide if rentals are a prob-

lem. The issues include life safety questions, the impact on rental rates, septic loading, noise and parking.

Doll museum finds new home in Fryeburg

FRYEBURG, Maine — Selectmen are forging ahead with a plan to lease the Fryeburg Town House building, which was

once used for voting, as the site of the Fryeburg Historical Society's proposed museum showcasing thousands of dolls.

The issue was discussed at the Jan. 19 selectmen's meeting.

Originally, the historical society wanted to use the old Registry of Deeds building, but that plan fell through because the town still needs it for document storage.
